## COMMENCEMENT OF WORKS

### THE UPGRADE OF THE EXISTING TERMINAL THROUGH THE ADDITION OF TWO NEW MODULES FOR PASSENGERS AND ASSOCIATED WORKS AT THE ANR ROBINSON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

#### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago (GoRTT), is expanding and upgrading the domestic area of the EXISTING ANR Robinson International Airport at Crown Point, Tobago.

The National Infrastructure Development Company Ltd (NIDCO) is the executing agency for this project, and China Railway Construction (Caribbean) Company Limited is the Contractor undertaking the design and construction.

#### ACTIVITIES ON THE PROJECT SITE

As part of the works, the Contractor shall be engaged in activities such as demolition, excavation, road works, drainage works, installation of services infrastructure, and building construction. The scheduling of such activities that may impact nearby receptors will be provided by the Contractor.

#### PROJECT SCHEDULE

**Proposed Start Date for the construction of the upgrade of the EXISTING terminal : 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2020**

**Duration: Five (5) months**

#### PROJECT LOCATION

The proposed site is bounded by aircraft parking to the South, airport staff car park to the North, airport taxi car park to the West and the EXISTING airport terminal building to the EAST.

#### CEC REQUIREMENTS

The proposed activities for this project (Ref No. CEC5837/2019) are as follows:

- Activity 10 (b) (ii) – Establishment of institutional facilities and other facilities.
- Activity 32 – Establishment of infrastructure for air transportation.

#### MITIGATION OF POTENTIAL NEGATIVE IMPACTS

- The anticipated adverse impacts associated with the activities listed above include fugitive dust, noise and vibrations, diesel fumes, and accident risk related to heavy equipment.
- All factors that may pollute the environment or create a nuisance will be considered by the Contractor; and the following mitigation measures will be put in place to avert or manage them:
- Dust reduction measures will be implemented.
- Stockpiled materials will be maintained in a dampened condition to prevent dust generation.
- There will be a designated area for washing of concrete trucks which will be impervious and bounded.
- Heavy equipment and vehicles will be regularly inspected and maintained.
- Construction safety signage will be erected and maintained.
- Lighting measures will be implemented to ensure illumination of potential hazards, warning signs and notices.
- Temporary hoarding will be placed along the boundaries of the site.

Please note that no unauthorised person(s) will be allowed to enter the construction site.
