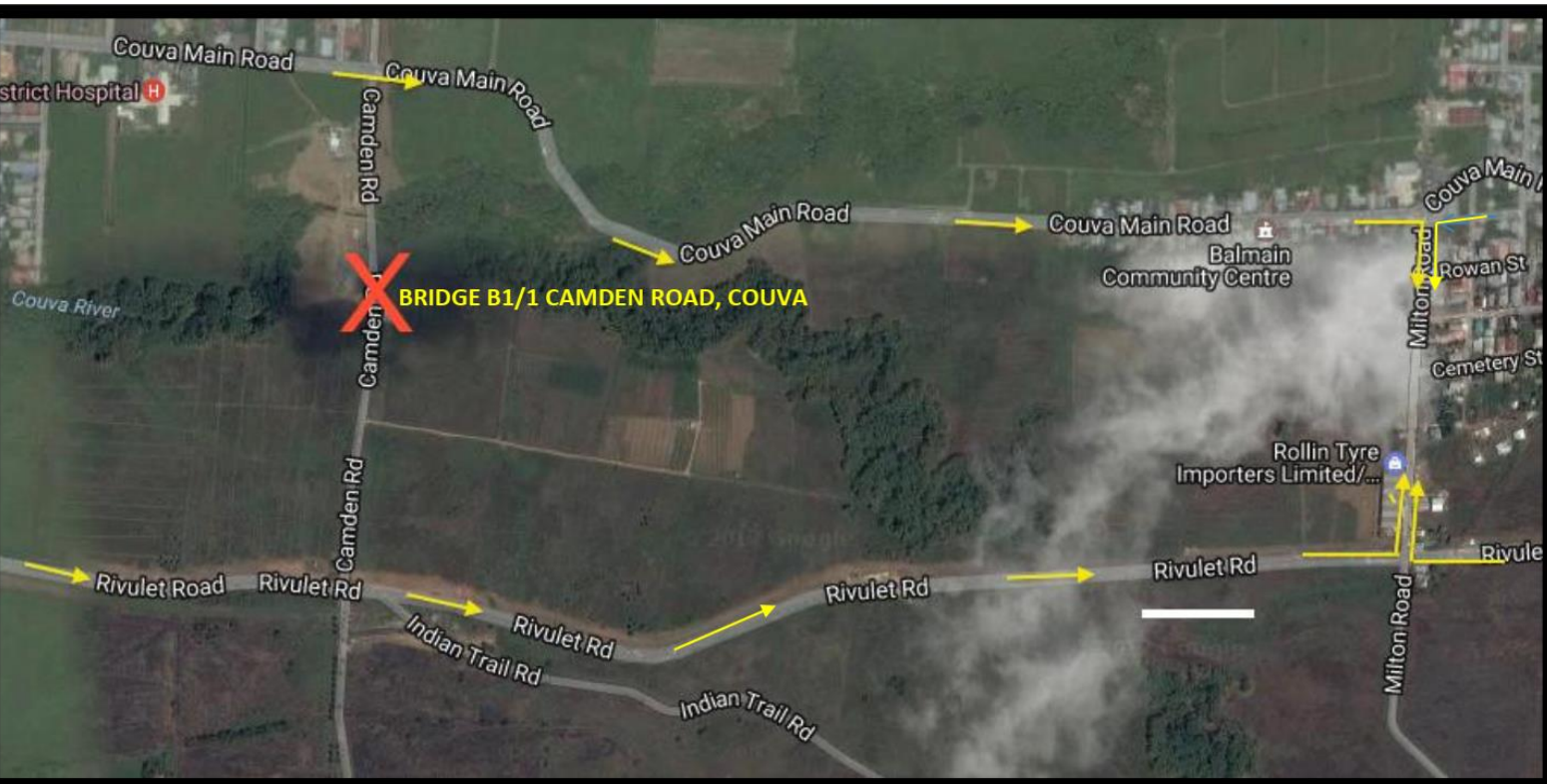
## REPAIRS TO APPROACH ROADS – BRIDGE B1/1 CAMDEN ROAD, COUVA - DETOUR ROUTES

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) in partnership with the Ministry of Works and Transport wishes to inform motorists/residents/pedestrians that repairs to the approach roads to the new **Bridge B1/1 Camden Road, Couva** will take place over the period **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 to Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021**.

To facilitate this work and in the interest of public safety, a temporary road closure is required. **Camden Road will therefore be temporarily closed at this location to vehicular traffic over the period Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 to Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021** while the approach roads are being repaired.

In keeping with the road closure, the public is advised to use the following detour routes, which are also illustrated in the map below.

- Traffic exiting the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway using the Preysal/Balmain Overpass and heading west along the Couva Main Road can turn left onto Milton Road to get to Rivulet Road.
- Traffic exiting the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway using Preysal/Balmain Overpass and heading west along the Rivulet Road can turn right at the traffic signals at Milton Road junction, and onto Milton Road to get to the Couva Main Road.
- Traffic heading east from Couva can continue along the Couva Main Road and turn right onto Milton Road to get to Rivulet Road.
- Traffic heading east along the Rivulet Road from the Point Lisas Roundabout can continue to the traffic signals at Milton Road, turn left onto Milton Road to get to the Couva Main Road.



In light of the above, motorists are advised to comply with the following:

- Proceed with caution and observe all temporary directional signs and barriers provided on the approaches to the site.
- Comply with instructions from Police Officers and or Site Personnel to facilitate a safe and orderly flow of traffic.
- Beware of heavy equipment entering and exiting the site.
