## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC DISRUPTION

### CONSTRUCTION OF A VEHICULAR OVERPASS IN THE VICINITY OF POWDER MAGAZINE AND RELATED ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) and the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) wish to advise the general public that there will be a temporary closure of a section of the Diego Martin Highway (DMH), Northbound and Southbound lanes, in the vicinity of Victoria Keys during the period: **Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 | 10pm to Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 | 3am**

The closure is necessary to facilitate the installation of bridge girders over the DMH as part of the ongoing Diego Martin overpass project.

**ALTERNATIVE ROUTES**

Motorists are advised that the following detours will be in effect:

- LEAVING DIEGO MARTIN** - Motorists travelling from the Diego Martin area should utilize the Four Roads Intersection and proceed toward the Western Main Road (WMR) via Westland Avenue and Morne Coco Road to exit Diego Martin.
- ENTERING DIEGO MARTIN & ENVIRONS** - Motorists travelling to Diego Martin should proceed along the WMR to Westland Avenue onto Morne Coco Road and utilize the Four Roads Intersection to enter into Diego Martin.
- The DMH from the Four Roads Intersection to WMR will be closed off to vehicular traffic and only accessible to local residents of Victoria Keys, Dangerous Corner, Mary Street, Wilson Road, William Road, Cuthbert Circular and environs. A temporary diversion will be in place in the vicinity of Wilson Road for these residents to access the Four Roads Intersection. Two-way traffic will be in place on the DMH Northbound from the Diego Martin Main Road to Victoria Villas to facilitate local residents in this area.
- Residents of Victoria Gardens and Victoria Villas should access their homes via the Diego Martin Main Road.
- Victoria Keys residents can access their homes via the existing northern entrance from the DMH and the existing southern entrance via Powder Magazine Road. Egress from Victoria Keys will be from the existing southern exit onto Powder Magazine Road.
- Two-way traffic will be in place on the DMH Southbound between Powder Magazine Road and the WMR to facilitate local residents in this area.



- Motorists are also advised to comply with the following:
- Proceed with caution and drive at a reduced speed on approaching the work zone.
  - Observe all temporary directional signage provided on the approaches to the site.
  - Comply with instructions issued by police officers on site to facilitate a safe and orderly flow of traffic.
  - Be aware of heavy equipment entering and exiting the site.

All precautions are being taken by the MOWT, NIDCO and its Contractor to guarantee that proper Health, Safety and Environmental Standards are maintained. We thank you for your continued cooperation and regret any inconvenience caused.
