MORUGA COASTAL PROTECTION WORKS-PHASE 1

The NATIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT COMPANY LIMITED (NIDCO) in partnership with the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT), invites suitably qualified and experienced Contractors to bid for the **Moruga Coastal Protection Works Phase 1** tender package under the Critical Coastal Protection Programme (CCPP).

SCOPE OF WORKS

The Scope of Works includes the Construction of 60m of reinforced concrete curved seawall with ACIP foundation piles, Construction of 80m rock toe protection, reconstruction of St. Peter's Statue base including removal and reinstallation of the Statue, Drainage and Ancillary Works. Additional details of the works are contained in the tender documents.

This Invitation to Tender (ITT) is open to all respondents who can demonstrate they have the experience, technical and financial expertise to provide the required services. Evaluation of proposals will be based on requirements including: **Organization & Experience, Financial Capacity, Available Manpower and Capability and Method Statement.**
