

PUBLIC NOTICE

SIR SOLOMON HOCHOY HIGHWAY EXTENSION TO POINT FORTIN (SHHEPF) PROJECT PARTIAL OPENING TO TRAFFIC - (DELHI ROAD TO VESSIGNY)

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) in conjunction with the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) advises the general public that a section of the Sir Solomon Hochoy Highway Extension Project between Delhi Road and Southern Main Road (SMR) Vessigny is **partially** opened to vehicular traffic during the period:

Monday 4th September 2023 to Saturday 30th September 2023

This provisional arrangement was made to improve vehicular flow between San Fernando and Point Fortin, by utilizing finished sections of the SHHEPF project as the new school year begins. The following sections of the SHHEPF are now accessible to the public:

- 4-lanes between Vessigny Roundabout and La Brea Interchange.
- 4-lanes between La Brea Interchange and Grants Road Interchange.
- 2-Lane between Grants Road interchange and Delhi Road.

Diversions of both Northbound and Southbound traffic, are in place at:

- La Brea Interchange, Grants Road Interchange and Delhi Road Overpass.

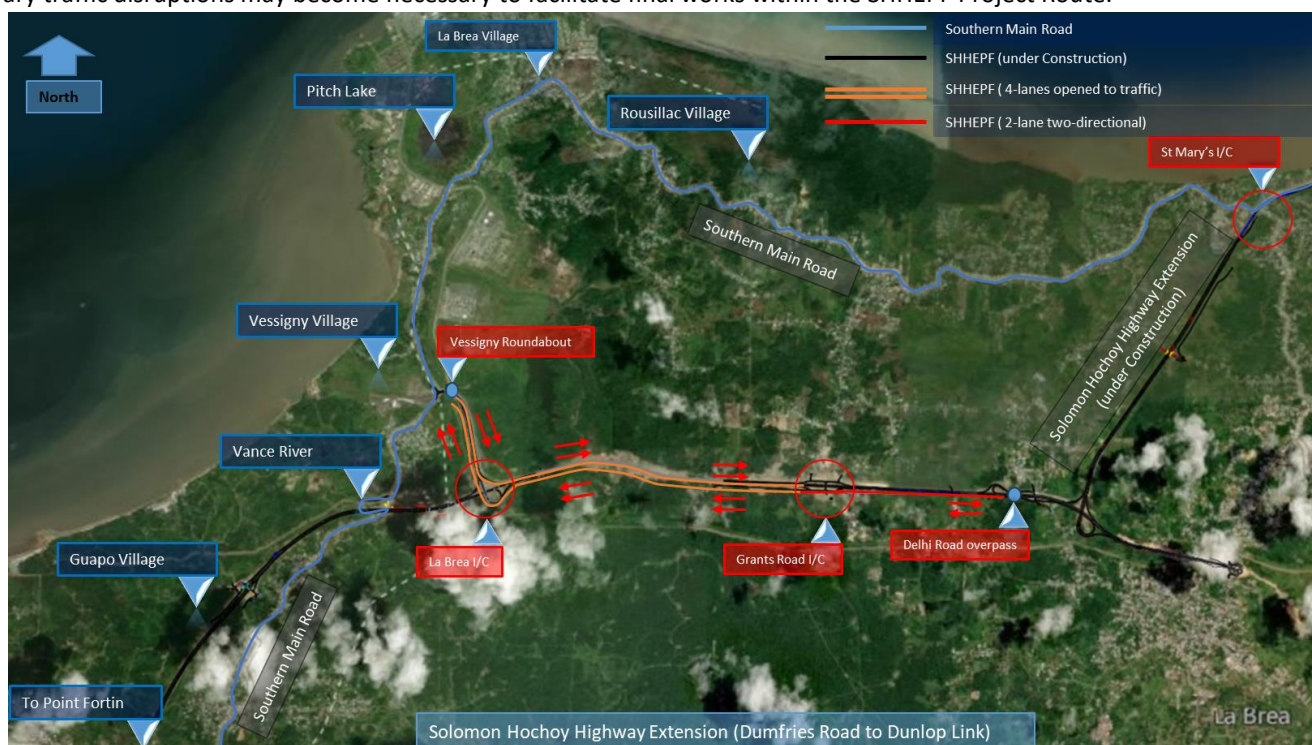
NIDCO further advises that construction works are continuing on other sections of the SHHEPF project, extending up to Dunlop Roundabout. It is intended that the completed section from Delhi Road to Vessigny as well as Vance River to Dunlop Roundabout will be completed and opened to vehicular traffic as four lanes by the end of September 2023.

Traffic arrangements during this period are as follows:

NORTHBOUND - SMR (VESSIGNY) TO MON DESIR: Motorists from La Brea and surrounding areas heading towards San Fernando can access the SHHEPF from SMR Vessigny Roundabout (opposite ANSAD Services Limited). Motorist can proceed South along the SHHEPF on 2-lanes towards the new La Brea Interchange and continue Eastwards on 2-lanes towards Grants Road Interchange Road. A diversion at the new Grants Road interchange is in place for safe traffic flow to access 1-lane traffic between Grants Road and Delhi Road. Motorists can then proceed northwards along the SHHEPF towards the new St Mary's interchange and onto San Fernando.

SOUTHBOUND - MON DESIR TO SMR (VESSIGNY): Motorists from St Mary's Village and surrounding areas heading towards La Brea can access the new section of the SHHEPF from Delhi Road overpass. Motorist should proceed West along the SHHEPF on 1-lane towards Grants Road Interchange Road. A diversion at the new Grants Road interchange is in place for safe traffic flow to access the section Grants Road to La Brea Interchange. Motorist can then continue North on 2-lanes from Grants Road interchange towards the La Brea interchange and continue using 2-lanes to the new roundabout constructed at Vessigny to access the SMR.

Interim minor temporary traffic disruptions may become necessary to facilitate final works within the SHHEPF Project Route.



Motorists are also advised to:

- Proceed with caution and drive at a reduced speed on approaching the work zone.
- Observe all temporary directional signage provided on the approaches to the work zone.
- Comply with instructions issued by police officers onsite to facilitate a safe and orderly flow of traffic.
- Be aware of heavy equipment entering and exiting the site.

All precautions are being taken by the MOWT, NIDCO and its Contractor to guarantee that proper Health, Safety and Environmental Standards are maintained.

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
