ELECTRO-TECHNICAL OFFICER (ETO)

JOB SUMMARY

The incumbent is responsible for ensuring the efficient operation and maintenance of electrical systems onboard. He/she provides technical guidance and support as the electricians install, maintain, and repair electrical systems, as required.

KEY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintains the electrical and electronic equipment onboard all vessels.
- Ensures that maintenance schedules for all electrical equipment are planned and followed closely.
- Troubleshoot any problems with the equipment or systems under his care.
- Diagnoses faults and potential problems and repairs where necessary.
- Assists all Chief Engineers and other members of the Maintenance Department with tasks as delegated.
- Coordinates with Maintenance Technicians onshore when needed.
- Ability to modify electrical systems or make proposals for modification.
- Ensures all electrical systems meet safety standards and maritime regulations. Conduct regular safety drills and training for crew members regarding electrical systems.
- Maintain accurate records of maintenance activities, repairs, and upgrades. Generate reports for management and regulatory compliance.
- Manage the inventory of electrical spare parts and equipment. Coordinate with logistics to ensure adequate stock levels.
- Work closely with other engineering officers, including mechanical and electronic technicians, to ensure seamless integration of all systems.
- Provide training to crew members on basic electrical system operations and emergency procedures. Foster a culture of safety and awareness.

KEY SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

- An in-depth knowledge of electrical and circuitry layouts is essential.
- Ability to work unconventional hours, as he/she must be on call for electrical emergencies, on land or on the Water Taxi/Inter-Island vessels.
- Ability to project manage electrical installations.
- Strong problem-solving skills and the ability to work under pressure.
- Excellent communication and teamwork abilities.

QUALIFICATIONS/MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING

- STCW III/6 Electro-Technical Officer (ETO) License from an administration recognised by the Trinidad and Tobago Maritime Services Division (e.g. Jamaica, UK or accepted by the UK's administration) or a Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering.
- A minimum of five (5) years' experience as a Senior Electrician.
- Experience required in key area such as main electric generation plant; propulsion control systems and engineering propulsion systems; radio communication systems; IT systems; electronic navigation aids such as echo sounders and autopilot systems; fire alarms and detection systems and Battery backup systems.
- Electrical experience in the marine industry is a plus.
- Meets the specified requirements for fitness.
