Completion of Out of Water Drydocking Works Inter- Island Ferries - April 2024

The Management of the Trinidad and Tobago Inter-island Transportation Company Limited (TTIT) wishes to advise the travelling public that the drydocking works to the APT James and the Buccoo Reef have been completed. The T&T Spirit has completed its major out of water works and will continue its remaining repairs while the vessel is in the water, alongside the GSS Jetty. The T&T Spirit is, at present, atop the Heavy Lift Vessel – M.V. White Marlin at anchorage at CARIDOC awaiting to be un-berthed.

To un-berth the T&T Spirit, the HLV White Marlin had to be removed to anchorage where it will be submerged to about 16m to float off the T&T Spirit. This procedure which commenced at 1300hrs today (Thursday 4th April) will take about 16hrs to complete. In the circumstances all technical operations (tugs, pilots, etc.) will commence during daylight- at 6.00am on Friday 05 April, 2024, following which the T&T Spirit will be towed back to the GSS Jetty, in Port of Spain.

The Travelling Public is reminded that the use of a Heavy Lift Vessel was secured to be used as a floating dock for works on the A.P.T. James, the Buccoo Reef and the T&T Spirit. Altogether the repair works were scheduled to be completed within 53 days.

In response to information circulating in the media, the crew on the T&T Spirit "has not been abandoned at sea with no means of relief." In fact, the Crew on the vessel is aware of the operations involving the un-berthing of the vessel and have been provided with all necessary supplies for the care and well-being of our personnel on board. All payments for the operations on the M.V. White Marlin have been made to the Ship's agent.
