DISRUPTION OF THE WATER TAXI SAILING SCHEDULE DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) advises the public that the Water Taxi Service has been temporarily disrupted due to adverse sea conditions caused by inclement weather. This morning, both sailings faced challenges while attempting to dock at the Port-of-Spain terminal. To ensure the safety of all passengers and to prevent any potential damage to the vessels, both sailings had to return to San Fernando without allowing passengers to disembark. Additionally, the 8:30 a.m. sailing from San Fernando was cancelled.

NIDCO regrets any inconvenience caused and assures the public that the safety of passengers remains our top priority. NIDCO is closely monitoring the weather and sea conditions and will provide updates regarding the afternoon sailing schedule as soon as possible.

Once again, we apologise for this temporary disruption and ask the travelling public for their continued understanding and cooperation until the safe resumption of service.
