

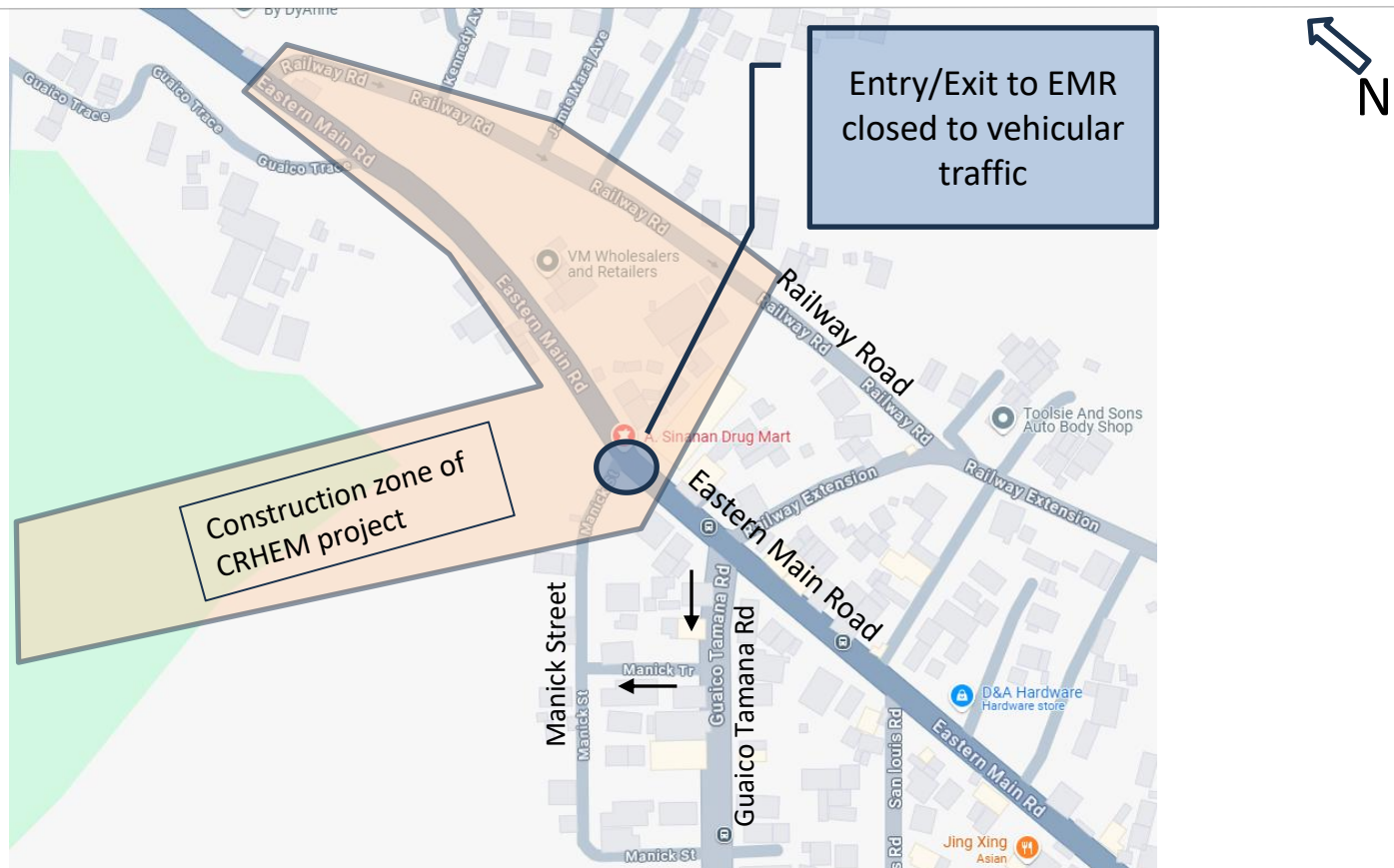
PUBLIC NOTICE

CLOSURE OF THE ACCESS/EGRESS TO THE EASTERN MAIN ROAD FROM MANICK STREET CONSTRUCTION OF THE CHURCHILL ROOSEVELT HIGHWAY EXTENSION (CRHEM)

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) and the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) wish to advise the general public that the access/egress to the Eastern Main Road from Manick Street will be permanently closed starting **March 11th 2025**.

This closure is part of the final traffic arrangements for the ongoing CRHEM project. Motorists are advised of the following.

1. Vehicular access to and from the Eastern Main Road via Manick Street will no longer be available.
2. Drivers wishing to access Manick Street, should now use the Guaico Tamana Road and then proceed to Manick Trace.



Motorists are also advised of the following:

- Work on the CHREM project is ongoing.
- Proceed with caution and observe all directional signage in the vicinity of Manick Street.
- Comply with instructions given by police officers on-site to ensure a safe and orderly flow of traffic.
- Be aware of heavy equipment entering and exiting the work site.

All precautions are being taken by the MOWT, NIDCO and its Contractor to guarantee that proper Health, Safety and Environmental Standards are maintained.
