

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## TEMPORARY TRAFFIC DISRUPTION AT THE INTERSECTION OF SADDLE ROAD AND SAM BOUCAUD EXTENSION ROAD, SANTA CRUZ

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) and the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) are advising the general public (motorists/residents/pedestrians) of the nightly, temporary traffic disruption at the intersection of Saddle Road and Sam Boucaud Extension Road, Santa Cruz between the hours **9:00 pm to 4:00 am** from **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025 to Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2025**.

This temporary traffic disruption is necessary to facilitate the roadworks associated with the construction of the new bridge located at the intersection of Saddle Road and Sam Boucaud Extension Road. Motorists are advised however that the following alternative routes for Westbound and Eastbound Traffic will be in effect:

### ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

#### WESTBOUND TRAFFIC



- Motorists proceeding west along Saddle Road should turn left unto Money Street, turn right unto Stollmeyer Street, turn right unto Sam Boucaud Road to Saddle Road.

#### EASTBOUND TRAFFIC



- Motorists proceeding east along Saddle Road should turn left unto Cutucupano Road, keep right unto Blaisney Road, turn right unto Foster Block Road, turn right unto Akal Road, turn left unto Akal Trace, turn left unto Akal Trace No. 2, proceed to Saddle Road.

**Motorists are further advised that signage and police officers will be placed along the routes to guide the travelling public.**

All precautions are being taken by the MOWT, NIDCO and its Contractor to guarantee that proper Health, Safety and Environmental Standards are maintained.
