TEMPORARY TRAFFIC DISRUPTION ALONG THE NAPARIMA MAYARO ROAD BETWEEN LP# 808 TO LP#811 (ABSOLOM TRACE) IN LIBERTVILLE, RIO CLARO TO FACILITATE LANDSLIP REPAIRS

The National Infrastructure Development Company (NIDCO) and the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) wish to inform motorists, residents, and pedestrians that landslip repair works will commence along the Naparima-Mayaro Road between LP #808 and LP #811 (near Absolom Trace) in Libertville, Rio Claro, beginning April 2025.

To facilitate the landslip repair work, a temporary single-lane traffic system will be implemented along a 75-meter section of Naparima-Mayaro Road near Absolom Trace (adjacent to the work site) from **Tuesday 29th April 2025**, for a period of six (6) months.

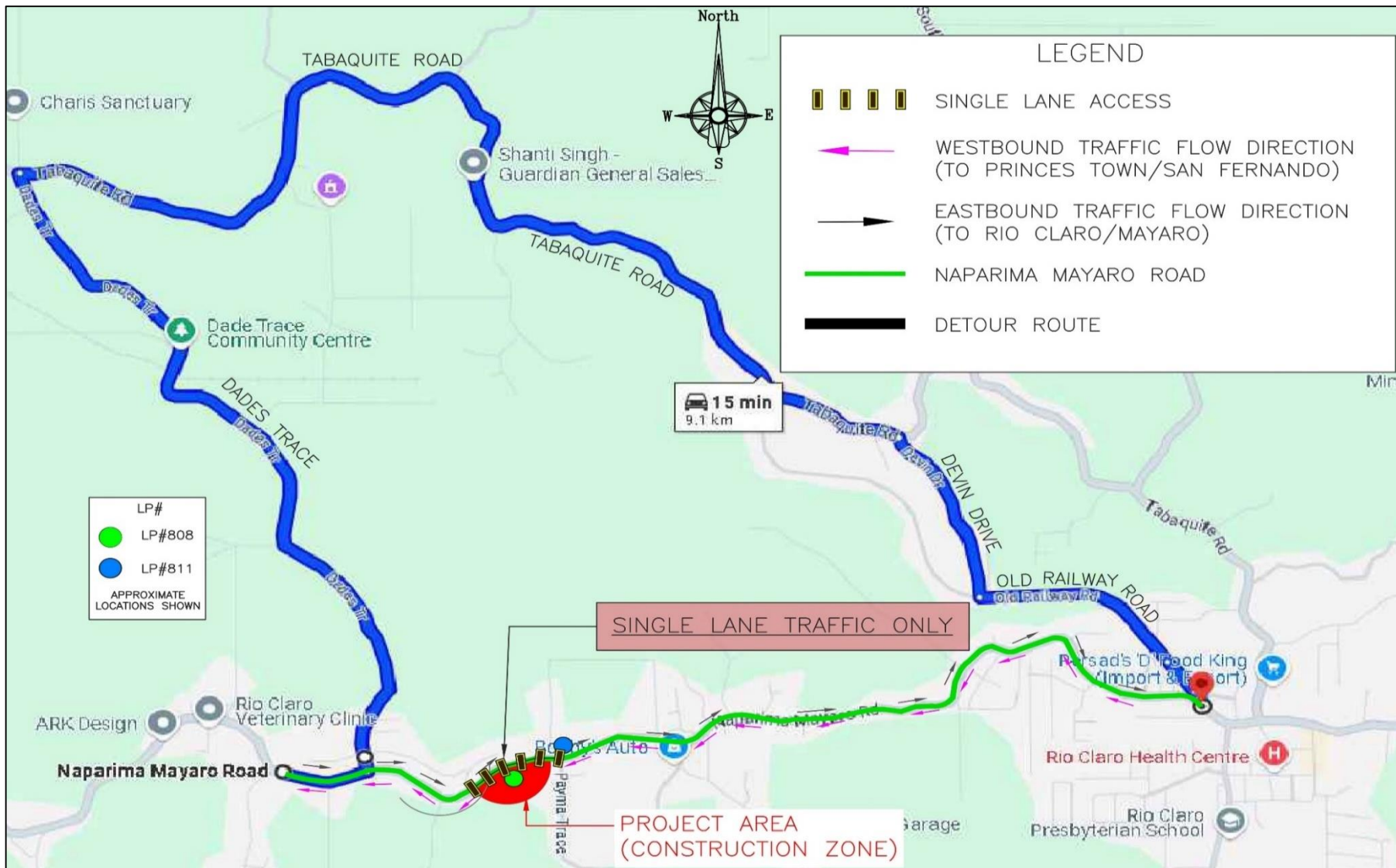
Motorists are advised as follows:

Controlled single-lane traffic will operate through the work zone.

- Intermittent stoppages will be managed by traffic police officers and flag persons.
- Reduced speed limits will be enforced in the construction area.
- Caution required for heavy equipment entering/exiting work zones.

Recommended Detour:

In keeping with the temporary single-lane traffic restriction, the public is also advised to use the **detour route as indicated in the map below**.
