NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS AT CUMUTO ROAD (CUMUTO) AND EMR (GUAICO, SANGRE GRANDE) CHURCHILL ROOSEVELT HIGHWAY EXTENSION (PHASE 1)

The National Infrastructure Development Company (NIDCO) and the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) advise motorists, residents, and pedestrians of upcoming changes to traffic arrangements at Cumuto Road (Cumuto) and Eastern Main Road (Guaico, Sangre Grande) effective **Thursday 24th April 2025, at 6:00 p.m.** These changes form part of Phase 1 of the Churchill Roosevelt Highway Extension project.

Motorists are advised of the following:

- Phase 1 of the Churchill Roosevelt Highway Extension project connecting Cumuto Road to Sangre Grande can be utilized by vehicular traffic.
- One-way traffic will be in effect for motorists heading northwest along Eastern Main Road between Railway Road Extension and Railway Road; as well as southeast along Railway Road and west along Railway Road Extension.
- Entry to Manick Street from EMR will be prohibited. Motorists are directed to use Guaico Tamana Road as an alternative route.



Motorists are also cautioned of the following:

- Works on the project are ongoing.
- Proceed with caution and observe all directional signage provided.
- Comply with instructions issued by police officers/traffic wardens to facilitate a safe and orderly flow of traffic.
- Be aware of heavy equipment operating in the vicinity of Guaico, Sangre Grande.
