- Construction of drainage infrastructure including culverts and associated drainage structures;
- Construction of retaining structures where applicable;
- Utility coordination, protection and reinstatement;
- Traffic management during construction;
- Installation of guardrails and road safety barriers;
- Road markings and traffic signage;
- Environmental management and erosion control measures;
- Quality assurance, quality control and material testing;
- Preparation of as-built drawings and completion documentation; and
- Site restoration and demobilisation.

This Invitation to Tender (ITT) is open to all respondents who can demonstrate they have the experience, technical and financial expertise to provide the required services. Evaluation of proposals will be based on requirements including: **Background Information & Organization of the Entity and Record of Performance** including Utilization of Local Resources and Executive Summary, Financial Capacity of the Respondent, Available Manpower and Capability, Available Plant, Equipment and Material, General Experience and Similar Work Experience, Management and Implementation Strategy.

Following the proclamation of the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Property 2015, Contractors who are desirous of providing goods, works or services to NIDCO, are advised that they must first be registered with the Office of the Procurement Regulation (OPR).
